**SETUP & MATERIALS<sup>1</sup>**

\$25 per hour per employee special request and research fee (1/2 hour increments)

\$0/layer for county-maintained data (shapefile, coverage, geodatabase, TIFF, MrSID, etc)<sup>3</sup>  
\$0/layer for non-county maintained data (shapefile, coverage, geodatabase, TIFF, MrSID, etc)<sup>4</sup>  
\$75 for Assessor table data (ownership, CAMA, etc)<sup>5</sup>  
\$100/ArcViewer project<sup>6</sup>

**DOLORES RIVER VALLEY AERIAL DATA<sup>8</sup>**

\$20/photo tile (1/2 mile X 1/2 mile) for digital aerial images (TIFF)  
\$250/township for digital aerial images (MrSID @ 20 compression)  
\$1000/whole project area for digital aerial image (MrSID @ 30 compression)  
\$35/township for 2-foot contour data (coverage)  
\$35/township for digital terrain model (TIN)  
\$20/township/layer for planimetric data (coverage)

**PUBLIC HEARING RECORDING FEES**

**SETUP & MATERIALS<sup>9</sup>**

\$15 setup fee per copy per public hearing (unless continues by the Board of Commissioners<sup>9</sup>)  
\$1 per CD required per copy per public hearing<sup>10</sup>  
\$10 shipping & handling<sup>2</sup>  
\$25 per hour per employee special request and research fee (1/2 hour increments)

- 1 Setup and materials fees apply to all electronic data and project purchases. Setup fees are based on 15 minutes employee time per data request. Requests requiring additional employee time will be charged additional fees based on \$25 per hour per employee. Setup fees do not apply to paper map purchases.
- 2 Shipping and handling only apply to requests requiring shipment of maps, data and/or public hearing recordings. Fees may be more if the shipping exceeds \$10 due to weight, size and/or delivery time needed
- 3 County maintained data includes data that is created and/or maintained by any Montezuma County staff including parcels, ownership, roads and special districts
- 4 Non-county maintained data includes data that has been acquired by Montezuma County from another source in final format. Data that has been acquired from another source but is further maintained by Montezuma County is considered "county maintained"
- 5 Assessor table data includes data that is created and/or maintained by the Montezuma County Assessor's Office. The fee includes a standalone table in Excel, Access or dBase format or data can be included within GIS layers (shapefile, geodatabase, etc)
- 6 ArcViewer projects are self-contained GIS maps that run using ESRI's free ArcReader software. The maps contain Montezuma County data and GIS capabilities including printing, measuring and querying data. ArcViewer projects expire 3 months after date of purchase
- 7 All maps printed from large format plotter are reduced 20% when 2 or more maps are purchased (example: 5 36X48 maps with imagery = \$180)
- 8 Dolores River Valley Aerial Data was produced by Sanborn, Inc for use in updating the FEMA floodplain maps for the Dolores Valley. This data was based on high- standard survey and aerial imagery dated May, 2003. Imagery and planimetric data fees have been depreciated to account for dating. Contour and elevation data have not been depreciated.
- 9 Public hearing recordings are available from Board of County Commissioners and the Montezuma County Planning Commission. Setup fees are based on approximately 15 minutes required for one employee to process a public hearing request. Requests requiring additional employee time will be charged additional fees based on \$25 per hour per employee. Continued hearings required by the Board of County Commissioners are not charged as an additional recording request.
- 10 Public hearings are available in standard audio CD or mp3 file format (requires computer or audio equipment compatible with mp3 files). NOTE: mp3 files are highly compressed and will fit approximately 600 hours of recordings per CD.
