a. By permit/regulatory limitations:

- Potential hazardous materials and waste (non-household) in large volumes greater than 5 gallons as defined by the Hazardous Waste Commission pursuant to 25-15-302 C.R.S. and 40 CFR Part 261
- Automobile batteries (lead-acid)
- Computer & TVs (commercial, industrial, institutional only)
- PCBs
- Radioactive wastes
- Tires (Residential)
- Volatile and flammable waste
- Liquid waste or waste containing free-liquids (particularly waste oil, paint, septage, contaminated water or liquids),
- Sludges, septic tank pumpings, or chemical toilet wastes not approved by county and CDPHE (dewatered/denatured sludge approved)
- Institutional wastes considered biomedical or biohazardous
- Unlabeled 55 gallon drums (not empty),
- Industrial process waste not pre-approved by county and CDPHE (Requires content/chemical documentation)

b. By facility management policy.

- Hot ashes (e.g. burn barrel wastes that are “hot”)
